

ORDER OF THE GROUP INSURANCE BOARD
ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Group Insurance Board by section 66.919 (3) (a) Wis. Stats., and in conformity with chapter 227 Wis. Stats., the board hereby repeals, recreates and adopts rules as follows:

Rules Grp 5.01 (2) and 5.02 are repealed. Rules Grp 5.01 (1) and (3) are repealed and recreated to read:

Grp 5.01 (1) Priority of designations. The last written designation of beneficiary or beneficiaries by the insured properly completed and on file with the director at the time of death, and dated and signed by the insured subsequent to any other written designation theretofore filed shall be in effect, provided that in the case of the intervening death of the insured a written designation shall be in effect if received by the director prior to the issuance of any draft or other form of settlement for the insurance of such insured.

Grp 5.01 (3) A beneficiary designation filed by an insured employe while in state employment shall have no effect with respect to insurance coverage in any municipality.


Rule Grp 13.02 is repealed. Rules Grp 13.01 (1) and (2) are repealed and recreated to read:

Grp 13.01 (1) Priority of designations. The last written designation of beneficiary or beneficiaries by the insured properly completed and on file with the director at the time of death and dated and signed by the insured subsequent to any other written designation theretofore filed shall be in effect, provided that in the case of the intervening death of the insured a written designation shall be in effect if received by the director prior to the issuance of any draft or other form of settlement for the insurance of such insured.

Grp 13.01 (2) A beneficiary designation filed by an insured employe with respect to insurance coverage in a particular municipality shall have no effect with respect to insurance coverage in any other municipality or the state.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on the first day of the month following their publication in the Wisconsin administrative register pursuant to section 227.026 (1) Wis. Stats.
