ORDER OF THE STATE BOARD OF HEALTH

AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Board of Health by Sections 140.05 (3) and 146.30 (2), Wisconsin Statutes, the State Board of Health hereby amends Section H 33.151 of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE relative to the qualifications of persons administering oxygen in nursing homes, as follows:

Section H 33.151 is amended to read:

H 33.151 Use of oxygen. Oxygen shall not be used in nursing homes unless there is a registered nurse in attendance excepting that in an emergency a person trained in the use of oxygen may administer oxygen. Signs indicating "No smoking" or "Do not strike matches" shall be posted in and at the entrance of the room when oxygen is in use.

The amendment contained herein shall take effect on December 1, 1963 as provided in Section 227.026 (1), Wisconsin Statutes, subject to approval under the provisions of Section 14.225, Wisconsin Statutes.
