ORDER ADOPTING RULE

Notice of the proposed creation of section PSC 15.025, Wisconsin Administrative Code, was published in the Notice Section of the Administrative Register. The Commission has received no petition for public hearing as provided for in section 227.02(1)(e), Statutes.

Order

THE COMMISSION THEREFORE ORDERS:

1. That pursuant to authority vested in the Public Service Commission by sections 194.04 and 194.37(3), Wis. Stats., the Public Service Commission creates and adopts section PSC 15.025, Wisconsin Administrative Code, to read as follows:

PSC 15.025 Licenses; assignment; amendment; fees. The simultaneous filing of more than one application does not avoid the payment of the statutory fee with each application except that, in contract motor carrier cases, only one fee shall be required when an application for assignment and an application for amendment are filed simultaneously by one applicant. However, even though such applications for assignment

and for amendment are filed simultaneously by one applicant, said applicant may elect to have the applications treated separately and pay the fees as though filed separately.

Note: The above election can be made to avoid having an application for approval of assignment set for hearing when it would not otherwise be so set (see section PSC 2.80(6)) but which would be set for hearing if filed with an application for amendment which would be set for hearing.

2. That certified copies of the above adopted rule be filed with the Secretary of State and Revisor of Statutes, as required by section 227.023, Statutes.

3. That the above adopted rule become effective December 1, 1963, under the provisions of section 227.026(1), Statutes.
