I, Harry H. Joyce, Acting Executive Secretary of the State Teachers Retirement Board, and custodian of the official records of said Board, do hereby certify that the annexed amendment to rules and regulations relative to permitting the following options was approved and adopted by this Board on April 18, 1964:

Combined 10 year guaranteed-life and joint survivorship annuity - annuity payable in full for the 10 year certain period and as long thereafter as both annuitant (member) and beneficiary are alive. Payments reduced by 25% upon death of either the annuitant or beneficiary but not before 10 year certain period has expired - effective June 1, 1964;

Joint survivorship annuity - payments reduced by 25% upon death of either the annuitant (member) or beneficiary - effective June 1, 1964.

**ORDER OF THE STATE TEACHERS RETIREMENT BOARD
AMENDING RULES**

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Teachers Retirement Board by sections 42.22(7), 42.243(7)(a) and 42.34, Wisconsin Statutes, the State Teachers Retirement Board hereby amends rules as follows:

Section TR 12.01 (1) (a) of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is amended to read:

- (a) Life, cash refund, and joint survivorship annuities - effective October 1, 1962;

Combined 15 year guaranteed-life and joint survivorship annuities - effective June 1, 1963;

Combined 10 year guaranteed-life and joint survivorship annuity - annuity payable in full for the 10 year certain period and as long thereafter as both annuitant (member) and beneficiary are alive. Payments reduced by 25% upon death of either the annuitant or beneficiary but not before 10 year certain period has expired - effective June 1, 1964;


Joint survivorship annuity - payments reduced by 25% upon death of either the annuitant (member) or beneficiary - effective June 1, 1964.

Men---1 year younger
Women---3 months younger

The amendment to Rule TR 12.01(1)(a) contained herein shall take effect on June 1, 1964.
