ORDER OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

AMENDING RULE

Pursuant to authority vested in the Public Service Commission by chapter 194, Wis. Stats., the Commission hereby amends rule as follows:

Section PSC 16.31(1) (Introductory paragraph) and (1), Wisconsin Administrative Code, is amended to read:

PSC 16.31 Exemptions from rate and/or tariff rules. (1) Contract motor carriers are exempt from rate regulation and are not required to file rates or tariffs for the following operations:

(1) Local cartage which takes place entirely within an area comprised of one municipality and municipalities contiguous thereto as well as local cartage wholly within the following described area: All of Milwaukee County; the cities of Brookfield and New Berlin and the villages of Butler, Elm Grove, Lannon, and Menomonee Falls, and the town of Brookfield, Waukesha County; and the city of Mequon and the village of Thiensville, Ozaukee County.

The amendment contained herein shall take effect on October 1, 1964, as provided in section 227.026(1), Wis. Stats.
