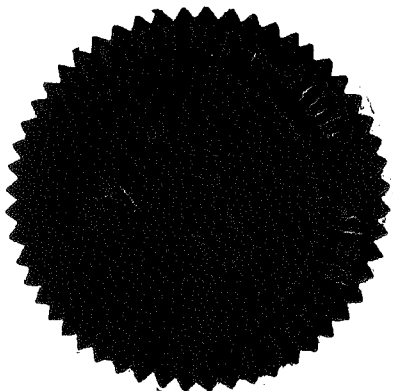

ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN
ADOPTING AND AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin by sections 29.085, 29.174 and 23.09, Wisconsin Statutes, the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby amends and adopts rules as follows:

SECTION 1. WCD 25.04 (1) (b) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 25.04 (1) (b)

(b) WHITEFISH	December 11 to October 14	December 11 to October 14	November 26 to October 24

SECTION 2. WCD 25.08 (1) (c) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 25.08 (1) (c) During the period from October 15 to December 10, in each year, no set hooks or gill nets other than gill nets with a mesh of not less than 2 1/2 inches or not more than 2 3/4 inches, shall be set, placed or operated in the waters of Lake Michigan or northern Green Bay except under permit from the Wisconsin Conservation Commission or its duly authorized agents.

SECTION 3. WCD 25.20 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 25.20 Icing and Refrigeration. It shall be unlawful from May 1 to September 30 for any person holding a license to conduct commercial fishing operations on any of the outlying waters pursuant to section 29.33, Wis. Stats. to conduct such fishing operations with a boat unless he carries on such boat a supply of ice sufficient to properly ice and chill all fish taken for human consumption, or unless such boat is adequately equipped with mechanical refrigeration to properly chill all fish taken for human consumption.

The rules herein contained shall take effect on December 11, 1964.
