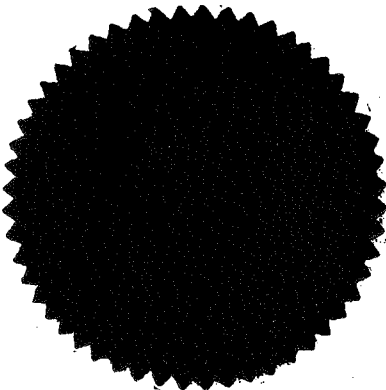

ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN
ADOPTING, AMENDING AND REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Conservation Director of the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin by sections 29.174 (4a), 23.09, and 227.027, Wis. Stats., and in accordance with section WCD 10.01 (1) (e) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code, the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby amends rules as follows:

Section WCD 10.01 (1) (a), of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.

Section WCD 10.01 (1) (b) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:
