ORDER OF THE STATE BOARD OF HEALTH

ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Board of Health by Sections 140.05 (3) and 50.02, and Chapter 143, Wisconsin Statutes, the State Board of Health hereby amends Section H 50.07 (2) and repeals and recreates Section H 50.10 (3) of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE relative to "Joint County Home and County Tuberculosis Sanatorium" as follows:

Section H 50.07 (2) is amended to read:

H 50.07 (2) Persons engaged in dishwashing shall not handle the sanitized dishes and other implements or engage in the handling or preparation of food unless they thoroughly wash their hands.

Section H 50.10 (3) is repealed and recreated to read:

H 50.10 (3) Personnel employed part time by both facilities shall thoroughly wash their hands and change their protective garments before leaving one facility to give care to patients in other areas of the institution.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on April 1, 1965 as provided in Section 227.026 (1), Wisconsin Statutes, subject to approval under the provisions of Section 14.225, Wisconsin Statutes.
