ORDER OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE
ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Department of Agriculture by sections 93.07 (1) and 97.09, Wis. Stats., the State Department of Agriculture hereby adopts rules as follows:

Section Ag 41.04 (6) of the Wisconsin administrative code is adopted to read:

Ag 41.04 (6) The cleaning procedures specified in subsection (1) of this section shall not apply to new non-returnable containers, provided that such new containers are basically sterile and have been securely protected from filth or other contaminants. New non-returnable containers shall be rinsed by spraying with water under pressure or by cleaning the container with air pressure.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on April 1, 1966.
