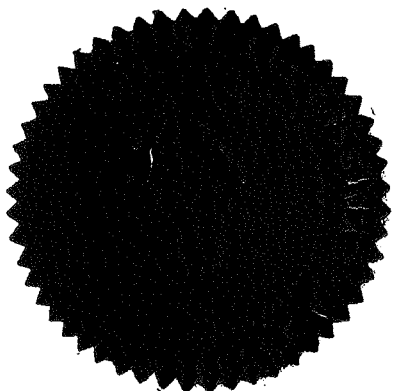

ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN, ADOPTING,
AMENDING AND REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin by sections 29.174, as amended by Chapter 400, Laws of 1965, and 23.09, Wisconsin Statutes, the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby amends and adopts rules as follows:

Section WCD 10.01 (2) (f) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 10.01 (2)

(f) Wild turkey.

An open season is established for hunting wild turkey with shotguns only in the following zone subject to WCD 10.25, Wis. Adm. Code:

All that part of Juneau and Wood Counties enclosed by a line beginning at the junction of State Highway 173 with State Highway 80; thence southwesterly along said highway 173 to its junction with State Highway 21; thence easterly along said highway 21 to its junction with State Highway 80; thence northerly along said highway 80 to its junction with State Highway 173 which is the point of beginning.

Apr. 16 through Apr. 30 1 male turkey
per season

Section WCD 10.02 (2) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 10.02 (2) There shall be no open season on prairie chicken, Canada spruce grouse (spruce hen), mourning doves, swans, cranes, bitterns, eagles, plovers, sandpipers, all species of hawks and owls except great-horned owls and except as provided in subsection (3) or on any other song birds or wild birds not specified in this chapter.

Section WCD 10.06 (2) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 10.06 (2) It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt or shoot any species of game except deer and bear, on which an open season is established, on any day during the open season before the time listed in the a.m. column or after the time listed in the p.m. column in the table in subsection (4), except as provided in sections WCD 10.01 (1), WCD 10.15 (4) and WCD 10.25, Wis. Adm. Code. There are no hunting hour restrictions for raccoon and all wild animals for which no closed season is established.

Section WCD 10.25 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 10.25 Wild turkey hunting permit.

(1) During the open season established under Section WCD 10.01 (2) (f) it shall be unlawful for any person to hunt wild turkeys unless he is in possession of a valid turkey hunting permit duly issued by the commission and is wearing the arm band issued with the permit.

(2) Any person holding a valid license authorizing the hunting of small game may file an application with the commission on forms furnished by it. Such applications shall be filed by mail and must be postmarked not later than March 29. Permits will be issued to applicants selected at random from all eligible applications filed. It is unlawful for any person to file more than one application, and all duplicate applications will be rejected.

(3) Each permit shall be valid for three consecutive days during the open season, and the total number shall not exceed 220 for any one 3-day period.

(4) It is unlawful for any person to hunt wild turkey in any manner in violation of the following wild turkey hunting permit restrictions:

- a. Shooting hours shall be from 5:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. CST.
- b. Weapons shall be restricted to shotguns only loaded with shot not larger than No. BB.
- c. During the open season period there shall be a closed season on all other game.
- d. No person shall use recorded bird calls or sounds, or electrically amplified imitations of bird calls or sounds.
- e. All turkeys killed during the open season shall be registered at the Meadow Valley conservation headquarters not later than 1:00 p.m. on the day killed.
- f. No person shall hunt turkeys with the aid of dogs.
- g. Each permittee shall be required to report information as specified on the permit.
- h. It is unlawful to hunt turkeys without a permit.

The rules and amendments contained herein shall take effect on April 1, 1966.
