ORDER OF THE STATE BOARD OF HEALTH AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Board of Health by Section 140.05 (3), and according to the procedure set forth in Section 227.02 (1) (e), Wis. Stats., the State Board of Health hereby amends the following rule:

Section H 1.23 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read as follows:

H 1.23 Procedure for applications for aid in hospital construction. Every hearing upon an application for federal aid in hospital construction shall be held at a place convenient to the applicant and may not be adjourned to any other place. A stenographic record of the hearing shall be made, and upon request of the applicant, be transcribed and made available for examination.

Decision upon such application shall be made in writing within 90 days from the date of the last day of the hearing. All proceedings upon such application shall be as prescribed in H 1.02 to 1.23 of these rules and chapter 227, Wis. Stats.

This amendment shall take effect on August 1, 1966 as provided in Sec. 227.026 (1), Wis. Stats., subject to approval under the provisions of Sec. 14.225, Wis. Stats.
