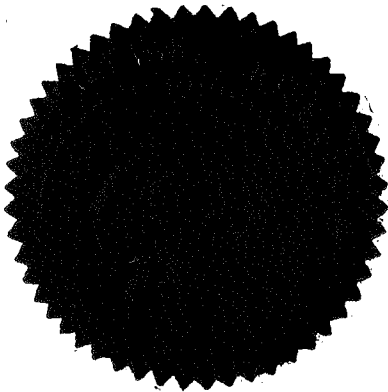

**ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN  
ADOPTING, AMENDING AND REPEALING RULES**

Pursuant to authority vested in the Conservation Director of the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin by sections 29.174 (4a), 23.09, and 227.027, Wis. Stats., the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby amends rules as follows:

Section WCD 10.15 (4) (c) 3a of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 10.15 (4) (c) 3a Reservation requests by mail only on official application forms will be accepted at the Wisconsin Conservation Department, Madison. Such requests must be postmarked no later than September 13. Applications which are postmarked after that date will be rejected.

The amendment contained herein shall take effect upon publication in the official state paper as provided in Section 227.027, Wis. Stats., as an emergency rule. Facts constituting the emergency are as follows:


The small game hunting license number must appear on the applications for reservations for the Horicon managed goose hunt. Distribution of small game licenses to the license depots in the various counties has been delayed. The result is that hunters have been unable to obtain 1965 small game licenses prior to the previously established deadline for postmarking such applications.

The preservation of the public safety and welfare necessitates the adoption of such rule as an emergency rule.
