ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN ADOPTING, AMENDING AND REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin by section 29.085, Wis. Stats., the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby repeals, amends and adopts rules as follows:

Section 1. Section WCD 25.03 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 25.03 Closed seasons. A closed season is established for each variety of fish and crayfish named in this chapter extending during all the time of the year except the open season period embraced within specified dates, both inclusive, and except as otherwise expressly provided no person shall take, catch or kill fish of any variety in excess of the daily bag limit and no person shall take, catch or kill fish or fish for fish by means other than as specified in this chapter, nor at any time other than the open season therefor, nor have in his possession or under his control any fish or crayfish in excess of the possession limit or below the minimum size therefor during the open season. Wherever a period of time is specified by dates in this chapter the first and last dates so specified are included in such period of time unless the context specifically provides otherwise.

Section 2. Section WCD 25.08 (1) (c) is amended to read:

WCD 25.08 (1) (c) During the period from November 1 to November 30 in each year, no set hooks or gill nets other than gill nets with a mesh of not less than 2 1/2 inches or not more than 2 3/4 inches, shall be set, placed or operated in the waters of Lake Michigan or northern Green Bay except under permit from the Wisconsin Conservation Commission or its duly authorized agents.

The rules, amendments and repeals contained herein shall take effect October 1, 1966.

Section 1. Section WCD 25.03 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 25.03 Closed seasons.
