ORDER OF THE INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION  
REPEALING AND RECREATING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Industrial Commission by section 102.15 (1), Wis. Stats., the Industrial Commission, after notice and hearing pursuant to chapter 227, Wis. Stats., hereby repeals and recreates a Workmen's Compensation rule as follows:

Section IND 80.29 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed and recreated to read:

IND 80.29 VALUE OF ROOM OR MEALS. In determining an employe's wages from any employing unit under chapter 108, Wis. Stats., any lodging or meals furnished as part of the employe's pay shall, unless a different specific showing is made, be valued as follows:

(a) Effective February 1, 1967, the value of a room shall be \$10.00 per week or \$1.40 per day; and

(b) Effective February 1, 1967, the value of meals shall be \$20.00 per week or \$.95 per meal.
