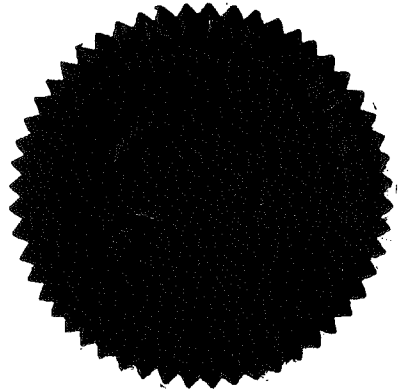

ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN  
ADOPTING, AMENDING AND REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Conservation Director of the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin by sections 29.174 (4a), 23.09 and 227.027, Wis. Stats., and in accordance with Sections WCD 10.01 (1) (a) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code, the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby amends rules as follows:

Section WCD 10.01 (1) (a) (open season column) is amended to read:

The amendment contained herein shall take effect the day of publication in the official state paper as provided in Section 227.027, Wis. Stats., as an emergency rule. Facts constituting the emergency are as follows:

The average daily kill of Canada geese in the area described in Section WCD 10.01 (1) (a) and (b) has exceeded the maximum number determined necessary to maintain an open season for hunting Canada geese for the period necessary to provide maximum hunting opportunity and to reduce agriculture depredations to a minimum in the area described in Section WCD 10.01 (a) and (b) and in the interest of the public welfare the season in the area described in Section WCD 10.01 (1) (a) should remain open on odd-numbered days of the month only.

The preservation of the public safety and welfare necessitates the adoption of such rules as emergency rules.


