

#### order of the state conservation commission of visconsin

ADOPTING, AMENDING, REPEALING AND CREATING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Visconsin, by section 30.251 (3) (h), Wis. State., the State Conservation Commission of Visconsin hereby adopts, amends, repeals and creates rules as follows:

SECTION 1. WCD 20.04 (5) (a) 3. of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 20.04 (5) (a) 3. Welf river-In, on or along that part of the Welf river lying in Menominee county, beginning at the head of the ledge rock area known as "The Trip" and located near the east line of section 27, township 30 north, range 15 east, extending downstream to the foot of "Ducknest Rapids" located just above the south line of section 27, township 30 north, range 15 east, as designated by signs posted by the Wisconsin Conservation Department on each bank of the Welf river at the beginning, and and within said described area.

SECTION 2. WCD 45.21 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 45.21 Wolf River Preservation Area: Menominee county. This section applies to the Wolf river preservation area defined in s. 30.251 (3) (a), Wis. State. as the waters of the Wolf river in Menominee county and within 200 feet outward from the shoreline of said river from the northern county

boundary through Keshens Fells.

- (1) Camping areas. Camping is prohibited at all times in the Wolf river preservation area except in the following designated campattes:
  - (a) Wolf Rapids campaite on county highway "WW".
  - (b) Della campaite in township 29 north, range 15 east, section 3.
  - (c) Smoky Falls compaite in township 29 north, range 15 east, section 2.
  - (a) Pine Row campsite in township 29 north, range 15 east, section 12.
  - (e) Turtle Rapids campsite in township 29 north, range 16 east, section 18.
- (2) It is unlawful for any person to operate a motorboat of any kind in any manner in the Wolf river preservation area.
- (3) It is unlawful for any person to take, catch or kill fish, or fish for fish by any means other than the use of an artificial fly by the method commonly known as "fly fishing" in, on or along that part of the Wolf river lying in Menominee county, beginning at the head of the ledge rock area known as "The Trip" and located near the east line of section 27, township 30 north, range 15 east, extending downstream to the foot of "Ducknest Rapids" located just above the south line of section 27, township 30 north, range 15 east, as designated by signs posted by the Wisconsin Conservation Department on each bank of the Wolf river at the beginning, end and within said described area.
- (4) The general public will be permitted ingress to and egress from the river in said preservation area only at the above designated campsites and at those places where public roads intersect or meet the river.
- (5) The provisions of sections WCD 45.02, 45.03, 45.04, 45.05, 45.06, 45.07, 45.10, 45.11, 45.12, 45.15, and 45.20 apply to said Wolf river preservation area.

The foregoing rules were made and adopted by the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin, in agreement with the county board of Menominee county, the town of Menominee and Menominee Enterprises, Inc., pursuant to s. 30.251 (3) (h) and certified copies of the resolution of agreement are attached hereto and filed herewith pursuant to s. 227.024 (6).

The foregoing rules were approved by the State Conservation Commission at a meeting duly held on the 10th day of March, 1967.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on May 1, 1967.
