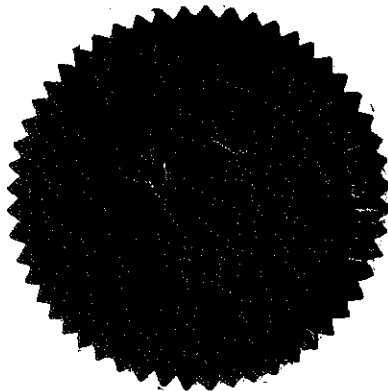

IN THE MATTER of repealing WCD 45.09 (6) (f); amending WCD 45.01 (3) (j), 45.17 (2) (e) and (3) and 45.18; repealing and recreating WCD 45.09 (4) (b) and (5) (c) and creating WCD 45.09 (1) (g) and 45.19 (3) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code relating to state parks, state forests and other properties under the supervision of the Wisconsin Conservation Commission.

ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN

ADOPTING, AMENDING, REPEALING AND CREATING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin, by sections 23.09, 23.11, 27.01 and 28.02, Wis. Stats., the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby adopts, amends, repeals and creates rules as follows:

SECTION 1. WCD 45.01 (3) (j) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 45.01 (3) (j) Family. A parent or parents with their children and not more than two lineal relatives or not more than two minor guests.

SECTION 2. WCD 45.09 (1) (g) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 45.09 (1) (g) Starret Lake in the Northern Highland State Forest, sections 13, 14, 23 and 24, T41N, R7E, town of Plum Lake, Vilas county.

SECTION 3. WCD 45.09 (4) (f) and (5) (c) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code are repealed and recreated to read:

WCD 45.09 (4) (f) Kickapoo Springs, section 14, T16N, R1W, town of Wilton, Monroe county.

(5) (c) No person shall remain overnight on any boat, watercraft or aircraft anchored, moored or docked at any commission-controlled dock, wharf, boat landing, marina, or other mooring area except at the marina at High Cliff State Park, at Steckton Island in the Apostle Islands State Forest, at Eagle Island (Horseshoe Island) in Peninsula State Park, at the campground in Merrick State Park, and at Rock Island State Park. The regular camping fees shall be charged for overnight occupancy of boats, watercraft or aircraft moored or anchored at Merrick and Rock Island State Parks.

SECTION 4. WCD 45.09 (6) (f) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.

SECTION 5. WCD 45.17 (2) (e) 2. and (3) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code are amended to read:

WCD 45.17 (2) (e)

2. Whitewater area

(3) The following areas are determined by the commission as state parks in which vehicle admission stickers or admission tags are not required pursuant to sec. 27.01 (2r) (b) (4), Wis. Stats.:

SECTION 6. WCD 45.18 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 45.18 It shall be unlawful for any person, except registered campers in or enroute to designated campgrounds, to enter or be in any state park or any camp or picnic area in any state forest or the

Yellowstone wildlife area between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and the following 4:00 a.m.

SECTION 7. WCD 45.19 (3) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 45.19 (3) No floating device of any kind is permitted in or upon the water in the swimming area at any supervised beach in any state park, state park recreation area, and the Kettle Moraine and Point Beach state forests.

The foregoing rules, amendments and repeals were approved at the March 10, 1967 meeting of the State Conservation Commission.

The rules, amendments and repeals contained herein shall take effect on May 1, 1967.
