ORDER OF THE INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION

Pursuant to authority vested in the Industrial Commission by sections 101.01 to 101.29 Wis. Stats., the Industrial Commission hereby repeals, recreates and adopts rules Ind 57.17 and Ind 57.19 as follows:

Repeal section Ind 57.17 and recreate as follows:

Ind 57.17 Size of rooms. (1) Every sleeping room shall be of sufficient size to afford at least 400 cubic feet of air space for each occupant over 12 years of age, and 200 cubic feet for each occupant under 12 years, except that a minimum of 150 cubic feet may be provided for infants in hospital nurseries. No greater number of occupants than the number thus established, shall be permitted in any such rooms.

(2) Except that for summer occupancy of Wisconsin Industrial camps between May 1 and October 15 inclusive every sleeping room shall be of sufficient size to afford at least 300 cubic feet of air space for each occupant over 12 years of age.


Repeal section Ind 57.19 and recreate as follows:

Ind 57.19 Windows. (1) The outside windows in every sleeping or living room shall have a total sash area of at least 1/10th of the floor area of the room but not less than 12 square feet. The openable area of such windows shall be equal to not less than 5% of the floor area of the room served.

(2) Except that for summer occupancy of Wisconsin Industrial camps between May 1 and October 15 inclusive the aggregate areas of window sash and screened outside doors in every sleeping or living room shall be at least 7.5 percent of the floor area of the room.

The rule contained herein shall take effect on July 1, 1967 as provided in section 227.
