RULE FW-PA 10.32 (10)(e)

1. Minimum education and experience. Graduation from an accredited 4-year college or university and completion of 12 graduate credits in an accredited school of social work. Each year of full-time employment as a caseworker in a public or voluntary agency may be substituted for 6 of the above-mentioned graduate credits providing the requirements for an in-service training certificate have been met and such certificate issued by the state department of public welfare. This certificate is awarded upon completion of 180 hours of participation in staff development activities, e.g., orientation, workshops and institutes.
