ORDER OF THE
PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN

Pursuant to authority vested in the Public Service Commission by sections 195.03 (17) and 195.34, Wis. Stats., the Public Service Commission hereby adopts a rule as follows:


Section PSC 72.04 (3) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

PSC 72.04 (3) Compliance with subsections (1) and (2), above, is required of all persons as defined by section 990.01 (26), Wis. Stats., which move, or cause to be moved, equipment by rail across or on a public way or thoroughfare over tracks owned by a railroad or tracks directly or indirectly physically connected with tracks of any common carrier by rail, whether such tracks are owned by a railroad or are owned by any other person as defined by section 990.01 (26), Wis. Stats.

The created rule contained herein shall take effect on January 1, 1968, as provided in section 227.026 (1), Wis. Stats.


