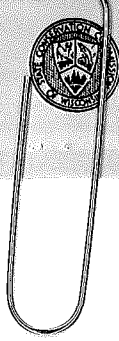


To All Whom These Presents Shall Come:

ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD

ADOPTING, AMENDING AND REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by section 29.174, Wisconsin Statutes, and section 25 of Chapter 75, Laws of 1967, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends rules as follows:

Section WCD 10.01 (2) (f) (open season column) and (bag limit column) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

3-1-68*

WCD 10. ⁰¹ 12 (2) (f)	Open Season (both dates inclusive)	Bag Limit
.	April 27 through May 12	One bearded male turkey per season.

Section WCD 10.25 (3), (5) and (7) (a) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 10.25 (3) Each principal and guest permit shall be valid for either two consecutive days or five consecutive days as specified on the permit. Not more than a combined total of 220 permits shall be issued for any two-day period or 340 permits for any five-day period.

(5) No person may hunt on any more than one of the designated hunting periods.

(7) (a) Shooting hours shall be from 5:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., CST.

The rules, amendments and repeals contained herein shall take effect on April 1, 1968.


