

ORDER OF THE STATE HEALTH OFFICER

PROMULGATION OF RULES


Pursuant to authority vested in the Council on Health by Chapter 327, Laws of 1967, and by Sections 30.71 and 140.05, Wisconsin Statutes, and in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 327, Laws of 1967, the State Health Officer hereby promulgates the following rules:

Sections H 80.02 (9) and H 80.12 of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE are ^{Created} amended to read:

H 80.02 (9) Toilet. A toilet is any device, facility or installation designed or constructed for use as a place for human defecation or urination.

H 80.12 Prohibited Facilities. No person shall use or permit to be used as a holding facility for human defecation or urination, a pail, plastic bag or any other type of portable, semiportable or disposable receptacle aboard boats not specifically permitted by the provisions of this chapter.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on May 1, 1968 as provided in Section 227.026 (1), Wisconsin Statutes, subject to approval under the provisions of Section 14.225, Wisconsin Statutes.
