

ORDER OF THE STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION
AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 348.25(3), Wisconsin Statutes, the Commission hereby rescinds and recreates Chapter Hy 30.01(3)(e)7 to read:

Section Hy 30.01(3)(e)7.

A permit authorizes the transportation of a load which overhangs the front or left side of the transporting vehicle or vehicles in excess of the statutory limitations, provided that such overhang shall be reduced to the practicable minimum by suitable positioning of the load on the vehicle and subject to compliance with the requirements of Subsection (3)(e)5.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Commission by Section 348.25, Wisconsin Statutes, the Commission hereby amends rules as follows:

Section Hy 30.01(3)(e)22 is amended to read:

22. Notwithstanding the height or width limitations which may be authorized by an individual permit, no vehicle or combination of vehicle and load exceeding 13½ feet in height or 12 feet in width or by reason of slow speed or other characteristic is likely to unduly interfere with normal traffic may be operated or transported upon any completed portion of the Interstate Highway System, nor upon any expressway constructed pursuant to Section 59.965, Wisconsin Statutes, except that:

a. A vehicle or combination of vehicle and load not exceeding 15½ feet in height may be operated or transported upon that portion of Interstate Highway 535 which lies within the State of Wisconsin at Superior.

b. A vehicle or combination of vehicle and load of any size or weight specified on the face of the permit may be operated on that portion of the completed portion of the Milwaukee County Expressway System designated as U.S. Highway 45 between West Florist Avenue and West Silver Spring Drive.

Pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 348.26, Wisconsin Statutes, the Commission hereby rescinds and recreates Chapter Hy 30.02(1)(d) to read:

Section 30.02(1)(d)

Upon the receipt of a satisfactory application for transport over a State Trunk Highway and provided the proposed transport meets the Commission's requirements and limitations as set forth in these rules, a permit may be issued by mail or, if requested, by collect telegram or teletype message in the form approved by the Commission by either the main or district office of the Commission. Permits issued on written, telegram and teletype applications may be extended for a period of two weeks for written applications and three days for telegram and teletype applications. Expired permits may be reinstated upon written, telegraphic or teletype request, which shall specify the number of the permit to be reinstated. Such reinstatement shall be for a period of not more than three days.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Commission by Section 348.25 and 348.26, Wisconsin Statutes, the Commission hereby rescinds and recreates rules as follows:

Chapter Hy 30.02(3)(d)

The vehicle towing an oversize mobile home under permit shall be a truck of not less than one and one-half tons manufacturer's rated capacity (11,000 G.V.W.) equipped with dual wheels on the drive axle.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Commission by Section 348.25 and 348.26(2), Wisconsin Statutes, the Commission hereby amends Chapter Hy 30.02(5) and adding Subparagraph (f) as follows:

Section Hy 30.02(5)(f)

Permits do not authorize the operation of more than two vehicles in combination except that an earth-mover may be transported with its power unit resting upon the bed of a semi-trailer and its single rear axle trailing on the roadway behind the semi-trailer, in which case the gross weight of the rear axle of the earth-mover shall not exceed 35,000 pounds. Such transporting of carry-all scrapers is prohibited over the Interstate Highways, including any partially completed sections, and also the following highways: U.S. Highway 12 from Black River Falls to Tomah, U.S. Highway 41 from Green Bay to Milwaukee.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Commission by Section 348.25(3) and 348.26(1)(2), Wisconsin Statutes, the Commission hereby amends rules as follows:

Section Hy 30.03(1)(a)

Amend by deleting the words "tire size, number of plies" from the fifth sentence.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Commission by Section 348.25 and 348.27(2), Wisconsin Statutes, the Commission hereby amends Chapter Hy 30.04(5) by adding Subsection (g) as follows:

Section 30.04(5)(g)

Annual permits do not authorize the operation of more than two vehicles in combination except that an earth-mover may be transported with its power unit resting upon the bed of a semi-trailer and its single rear axle trailing on the roadway behind the semi-trailer, in which case the gross weight of the rear axle of the earth-mover shall not exceed 35,000 pounds. Such transporting of carry-all scrapers is prohibited over Interstate Highways and the following highways: U.S. Highway 12 from Black River Falls to Tomah, and U.S. Highway 41 from Green Bay to Milwaukee.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Commission by Section 348.27(2) and 59.965, Wisconsin Statutes, the Commission hereby amends Chapter Hy 30.04(5) by adding Subparagraph (h) as follows:

Section Hy 30.04(5)(h)

No annual permit is valid for operation on any part of the Milwaukee County Expressway System, constructed pursuant to Section 59.965, Wisconsin Statutes, except on U.S. Highway 45 between West Florist Avenue and West Silver Spring Drive.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Commission by Section 348.25(3) and 348.27(1)(2), Wisconsin Statutes, the Commission hereby amends rules as follows:

Section 30.05(1)(a)

Amend by deleting the words "tire size, number of plies" from the second sentence.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Commission by Section 348.27(5) and 59.965, Wisconsin Statutes, the Commission hereby repeals and recreates Chapter Hy 30.12(5)(c) as follows:

Section 30.12(5)(c)

Vehicle transportation permits are not valid for operation on any part of the Milwaukee County Expressway System, constructed pursuant to Section 59.965, Wisconsin Statutes, except on U.S. Highway 45 between West Florist Avenue and West Silver Spring Drive.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Commission by Section 348.27(5), Wisconsin Statutes, the Commission hereby amends Chapter Hy 30.13(1)(a) as follows:

Section 30.13(1)(a)

Amend by deleting the words "whether the vehicle is to be used in interstate or intrastate commerce or both" from the second sentence.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Commission by Section 348.27(7), and 59.965, Wisconsin Statutes, the Commission hereby amends Chapter Hy 30.16(5) by adding Subparagraph (d) as follows:

Section 30.16(5)(d)

Annual permits are not valid for operation on any part of the Milwaukee County Expressway System, constructed pursuant to Section 59.965, Wisconsin Statutes, except on U.S. Highway 45 between West Florist Avenue and West Silver Spring Drive.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Commission by Section 348.25(3), and 348.27(7), Wisconsin Statutes, the Commission hereby amends rules as follows:

Section 30.17(1)(a)

Second sentence to read: "The forms shall provide a space for the applicant to indicate the make, license number, manufacturer's serial number and state of registration of the towing vehicle, the length, width, and height of the towing vehicle, mobile home and combination of towing vehicle and mobile home, a certification that the towing vehicle shall be a truck of not less than one and one-half tons manufacturer's rated capacity equipped with dual wheels on the drive axle, and that the applicant is a licensed mobile home manufacturer, dealer, or transport company, and the license number issued to the company and the issuing agencies".
