ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Agriculture by sections 93.07 (1) and (10) and chapter 95, Wis. Stats., the Department of Agriculture hereby amends rules as follows:

Section Ag 10.21 (4) (a) of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read:

Ag 10.21 (4) (a) All bovine animals over 2 years of age originating from herds in this state and received for sale or shipment to a slaughtering establishment, with the exception of steers, shall be identified with a back tag issued by the department. The back tag shall be affixed to such animal at a point 4 inches behind the shoulder and 4 inches below the top line.

The amendment of rules contained herein shall take effect as provided in section 227.026, Wis. Stats.
