SECTION 1. WCD 20.02 (1)(d) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed and recreated to read:

WCD 20.02 (1)



SECTION 2. WCD 20.02 (1)(f) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.


