ORDER OF THE ACCOUNTING EXAMINING BOARD
ADOPTING AND AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in Accounting Examining Board by section 15.08 (5), Wis. Stats., the secretary hereby adopts and amends rules as follows:

Section Accy 3.04 (4a) of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is adopted to read:

If any examination papers of a candidate were lost and consequently not graded and candidate could not attend the make-up examination, but had passed one of the subjects he wrote, he may present himself for re-examination at any regularly scheduled examination and will receive credit for the examination passed provided he passes one other subject in the re-examination.

Section Accy 3.04 (5) of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is amended to read:

A candidate who has failed to receive a passing grade in at least one subject may not present himself for re-examination until at least one examination shall have intervened following his last examination or re-examination excepting that if any examination papers of a candidate were lost and consequently not graded and candidate could not attend the make-up examination, he may present himself for re-examination at the next scheduled examination.

The rules and amendments contained herein shall take effect on May 1, 1971, as provided in section 227.026 (1), Wis. Stats.
