

Pursuant to authority vested in the DEPARTMENT OF EMPLOYE TRUST FUNDS, Division of Teachers, State Teachers Retirement Board, by section 42.22(2), Wis. Stats., the board hereby adopts the following rule:

CHAPTER 9
Disability Annuities


Section T.R. 9.01 is created to read:

T.R. 9.01 Board hearing on disability determinations
under sections 42.242(4)(c) and 42.245(3)(c).

(1) The initial determination of disability under sections 42.242(4)(c) and 42.245(3)(c), Wis. Stats., as provided therein, shall be made by the state agency designated by agreement with and for the secretary of health, education and welfare under the federal social security laws. Whenever said state agency reports to the board a finding of ineligibility on an initial determination, the member shall be promptly notified by mail of such finding of ineligibility and advised of his opportunity to request a hearing. Such request for hearing must be filed with the board within 60 days of the mailing of such notification.

(2) When a request for such hearing is received, the board shall set a date for hearing as expeditiously as possible.

The rule herein contained shall take effect as provided in section 227.026(1), Wis. Stats.
