

ORDER OF

DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRY, LABOR AND HUMAN RELATIONS

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations by sections 101.01 to 101.25, Wis. Stats., the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations hereby amends, creates, repeals, recreates and adopts rules of Wisconsin Administrative Code Chapter Ind 8, Flammable and Combustible Liquids.

The rules attached hereto shall become effective on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Code as provided in section 227, Wis. Stats.

Subsection Ind 8.02 (47) to be renumbered as (48).

Subsection Ind 8.02 (53) to be renumbered as (54).

Subsection Ind 8.02 (47) is created to read:

(47) Self-service station shall mean that portion of property where flammable or combustible liquids used as motor fuels are stored, and where the fuel is dispensed by the general public into the fuel tanks of motor vehicles or into approved containers by use of automatic dispensing units.

Note: See Ind 8.72 (3) for automatic dispensing units.

Subsection Ind 8.12 (1) (intro. par.) is repealed and recreated to read:

Ind 8.12 Approval of proposed construction, installation or operation.  
(1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (1) (c), before any construction of new or additional installation or change in operation of a previously approved installation for the storage, handling or use of flammable or combustible liquids is undertaken, written approval and/or approved plans shall be obtained from the department.

Subsection Ind 8.12 (1) (e) is created to read:

(e) Change of operation from that of a general service station to that of a self-service station, in part or in total, shall be approved by the department before commencing such operation.

Note: Also see requirements of Ind 8.12 (2) (c) and Ind 8.72 (3).

Subsection Ind 8.12 (2) (c) is repealed and recreated to read:

(c) Plans for general service stations and self-service stations shall be submitted to the department or its authorized representative as required by chapters Ind 50-59--Building and Heating, Ventilating and Air Conditioning.

1. General service stations being converted to self-service operation, in part or in total, shall require approval before such change in operation.

Note #1: For installation of new equipment at existing stations--see subsection (3).

Note #2: Buildings converted for use as a service station--see subsection (1) and Wis. Adm. Code, chapters 50-59, Building and Heating, Ventilating and Air Conditioning.

Note #3: Plans for service stations involving use of automatic dispensing units should indicate location of emergency controls--see subsection Ind 8.72 (3).


Subsection Ind 8.71 (1) (a) is created to read:

(a) The attendant's duties at self-service stations shall be as required in section Ind 8.72 (3).

Subsection Ind 8.72 (1) (intro. par.) is repealed and recreated to read:

(1) Location. Dispensing devices at service stations and/or self-service stations shall be so located that all parts of the vehicle being served will be on the premises of the station.
