## ORDER OF

## DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRY, LABOR AND HUMAN RELATIONS

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations by sections 101.01 to 101.25, Wis. Stats., the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations hereby amends and adopts rules as follows:

Section Ind 70.09 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended and adopted to read:

Ind 70.09 Fees for permits and certificate of age. The Department fixes a fee of \$1.00 for the issuing of each Child Labor Permit or Certificate of Age and authorizes the retention of such fee by the permit officer as compensation for his services.

Section Ind 71.02 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended and adopted to read:

Ind 71.02 Fees. The Department fixes a fee of \$1.00 for the issuing of each street trade permit and authorizes the retention of such fee by the permit officer as compensation for his services.
