
TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETINGS:

ORDER NO. M-27-72

ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD

ADOPTING, AMENDING AND REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by Sections 23.09, 29.085, 29.174 and 227.027, Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby repeals, amends and adopts rules as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 27.02 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

NR 27.02

(1) Permits may be issued by the Department for the taking, exportation, transportation or possession of any fish and wildlife on the list of the Wisconsin endangered species, for zoological, educational or scientific purposes and for propagation of such fish and wildlife in captivity for preservation purposes. Endangered species permits, issued in accordance with procedures established in NR 19.11, will be used to comply with the mandate of this section. Species that appear both on the federal and on the Wisconsin endangered list shall require both a federal and a state permit. Species appearing only on the federal list shall require a federal permit, but not a state permit.

(2) Taking, transporting, possessing, processing or selling within this state any fish and wildlife specified by the list of Wisconsin endangered fish and wildlife may be permitted by the Department in accordance with the following regulations. Species that appear both on the federal and on the Wisconsin endangered list shall require both a federal and a state permit. Species appearing only on the federal list shall require a federal permit, but not a state permit.

An application must be submitted to the Department stating the species, number, source and intended manner and time of use, of any endangered fish and wildlife to be utilized by the applicant. Following approval of this application, authorized endangered fish and wildlife obtained by the applicant must upon possession be shown to the Department or its deputies. Appropriate permits may be issued for live specimens. Furs shall be stamped or marked with a stamp or tag furnished by the Department to show such fish and wildlife are legally held and possessed.

Such permits for raw furs of furbearers on the Wisconsin endangered species list may be issued in accordance with this procedure. Permits will not be required for such furs when dressed or made into garments.


The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on November 9, 1972.

The rules contained herein shall take effect upon publication.


