ORDER OF THE PHARMACY INTERNSHIP BOARD ADOPTING AND AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Pharmacy Internship Board by section 15.08(5) and according to the procedure set forth in section 227.02(1)(b) Wis. Stats., the Pharmacy Internship Board hereby adopts the rules as follows:

Section Ph-Int 1.01(2)(a)2. of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is amended to read:

2. The application is to be accompanied by an annual registration fee of \$10.

Section Ph-Int 1.02(3)(a) of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is amended to read:

(a) Completion of 36 months practice as a registered pharmacist engaged in the compounding and dispensing of pharmaceutical preparations and physicians prescriptions and the supplying of drug and drug containing preparations in a registered pharmacy. The Pharmacy Internship Board may waive this requirement if the pharmacist, who has been licensed a minimum of 24 months, is to be a preceptor in a pharmacy in which there are one or more certified preceptors who meet the 36 month practice requirement, and one of whom is currently serving as a preceptor in an on-going internship program.
