ORDER OF THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE

Amending Rules

Pursuant to authority vested in the Commissioner of Insurance by section 601.41 (3), Wis. Stats., the Commissioner of Insurance hereby amends a rule as follows:

Section Ins 3.28 (5) (d) (introductory paragraph) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

Ins 3.28 (5) (d) An insurer shall, within 10 days after the issuance or amendment of a policy, contract or certificate, furnish to the policyholder, subscriber or certificate holder, where the application for the coverage or the amended coverage contains questions relating to the medical history or other matters concerning the insurability of the person or persons being insured and is part of the insurance contract, a notice, in the form of a sticker to be attached to the first page of the policy, a letter, or other form containing substantially the following:
