## ORDER OF THE VETERINARY EXAMINING BOARD ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Veterinary Examining Board by section 15.08(5), Wisconsin Statutes, and section 453.06, Wisconsin Statutes, the Veterinary Examining Board hereby adopts rules as follows:

VE 2.09 EXAMINATION FOR LICENSURE. The examination will consist of six parts, one part being the National Board examination and one part by each of the five professional members of the Board. The part prepared by the individual board member will consist of both a written and an oral-practical examination.

- (1) National Board score shall be reported by a percentage score.
- (2) The Board members shall report one score which shall be arrived at by scoring 20% for National Board, 40% for written portion, and 40% for oral practical portion.
- (3) A score of 70% or better is needed from three of the examiners before a license will be issued.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register or as otherwise provided in section 227.026, Wisconsin Statutes.
