

ORDER OF THE STATE ETHICS BOARD
ADOPTING RULE


Pursuant to the authority vested in the State Ethics Board by Chapter 227 of the Wis. Stats. and section 19.48(1)(a) of the Wis. Stats., the State Ethics Board adopts the following rule:

Section Eth 1.02(1) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

1.02(1) TEACHING PERSONNEL OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN SYSTEM.
"Teaching personnel of the university of Wisconsin system" are deans, principals, professors, instructors, research assistants, librarians and other teachers identified in section 20.293(6)(m), Wis. Stats.

The rule contained herein shall take effect as provided in section 227.026(1), Wis. Stats.

ADOPTING RULE

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State Ethics Board by Chapter 227 of the Wis. Stats. and section 19.48(1) of the Wis. Stats., the State Ethics Board adopts the following rule:

Chapter Eth 1.02(3) LEGAL DEPENDENT of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

1.02(3) Legal dependent means a parent or child of a state public official or of the spouse of a state public official who is receiving over one-half of his support from the state public official or from the spouse of a state public official.

The rule contained herein shall take effect as provided in section 227.026(1), Wis. Stats.
