ORDER ADOPTING RULES

ORDER OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT STANDARDS BOARD

ADOPTING, AMENDING, OR REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Law Enforcement Standards Board by Section 165.85 Wis. Stats., and in compliance with the requirements of Section 227.018 (2) Wis. Stats., whereby the State of Wisconsin Senate Judiciary and Insurance Committee and the State of Wisconsin Assembly Judiciary Committee were informed of the proposed amendment to LES 2.01 (1)(d), the Law Enforcement Standards Board hereby repeals, amends, and adopts as follows:

Section LES 2.01 (1)(d) of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is amended to read:

LES 2.01 (1)

- (d) The applicant shall not have been convicted of any federal felony or of any offense which if committed in Wisconsin could be punished as a felony unless the applicant has been granted an absolute and unconditional pardon.

The rules, amendments, and repeals contained herein shall take effect immediately pursuant to Section 227.026 (1)(a). The facts relative to this change are as follows: Subsequent to the publishing of a 30-day notice the Law Enforcement Standards Board, by unanimous vote, amended

LES 2.01 (1)(d) to reflect its belief that convicted  
felony offenders who have received absolute and unconditional  
pardons meet its minimum recruit qualifications.
