

ORDER OF THE PHARMACY EXAMINING BOARD
REPEALING AND ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Pharmacy Examining Board by sections 161.31 and 227.021, Wis. Stats., the Pharmacy Examining Board hereby amends rules as follows:

Section Phar 6.05 (5) of the Wis. Adm. Code is amended to read:

Phar 6.05 (5) No pharmacy, individual practitioner or other DEA registered dispenser shall dispense at any one time, and no individual practitioner shall prescribe for dispensing at any one time, a controlled substance in any quantity exceeding a 34-day supply or 120 dosage units whichever is less, except that up to a three month supply of any schedule III or IV anticonvulsant substance, as determined by the directed dosage and frequency of dosage, may be prescribed and dispensed at one time.

The amendments contained herein shall take effect on February 1, 1975 as provided in Section 227.026 (1), Wis. Stats.
