ORDER OF THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE

Amending and Adopting Rules

Pursuant to authority vested in the Commissioner of Insurance by section 601.41 (3), Wis. Stats., the Commissioner of Insurance hereby amends rules as follows:

Sections Ins 2.10 (1), Ins 3.21 (1), and Ins 3.27 (5) (b) 1 are amended to read:

Ins 2.10 (1) The phrase "in the same industry", as used in section 206.60 (4), Wis. Stats., may be construed so that establishments engaged in one of the following activities may be considered as being in the same industry: (a) retail trade, (b) wholesale trade, (c) service, (d) mining, (e) contract construction, (f) finance, insurance and real estate, (g) transportation, communication and other public utilities, and (h) manufacturing.

Ins 3.21 (1) The phrase "in the same industry", as used in section 204.321 (1) (c), Wis. Stats., may be construed so that establishments engaged in one of the following activities may be considered as being in the same industry: (a) retail trade, (b) wholesale trade, (c) service, (d) mining, (e) contract construction, (f) finance, insurance and real estate, (g) transportation, communication and other public utilities, and (h) manufacturing.

Ins 3.27 (5) (b) 1. Except such benefits contained in a policy providing another kind of insurance other than life, and
