ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD REPEALING AND RECREATING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by sections 147.04(1), 147.04(5) and Chapter 227, Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby repeals and recreates Chapter NR 220 as follows:

Chapter NR 220

Categories and Classes of Point Sources

NR 220.01 <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this chapter is to establish pursuant to section 147.04(1), Wis. Stats., a list of categories and classes of point sources other than publicly owned treatment works for which effluent limitations, pretreatment standards, standards of performance, and other standards are to be established.

NR 220.02 Categories and classes of point sources. Categories and classes

of point sources of pollutant discharge are as follows.

(1) Asbestos manufacturing.

(2) Builders paper and roofing felt.

(3) Canned and preserved fruits and vegetables.

(4) Canned and preserved seafood processing.

(5) Cement manufacturing.

(6) Chemical manufacturing, miscellaneous.

(7) Coal mining.

(8) Converted paper products manufacturing.

(9) Dairy products processing.

(10) Electroplating.

(11) Feedlots.

(12) Ferroalloy manufacturing.

(13) Fertilizer manufacturing.

(14) Fish hatcheries and farms.

(15) Food and beverage processing, miscellaneous.

(16) Glass manufacturing.

(17) Grain mills.

(18) Ink formulation.

(19) Inorganic chemical manufacturing.

(20) Iron and steel manufacturing.

(21) Laundries, auto and other.

(22) Leather tanning and finishing.

(23) Machinery and mechanical products manufacturing.

(24) Meat products.

(25) Mineral mining and processing.

(26) Nonferrous metals manufacturing.

(27) Ore mining and dressing.

(28) Organic chemical manufacturing.

(29) Paint formulation.

(30) Paving and roofing materials processing.

(31) Petroleum and gas extraction.

(32) Petroleum refining.

(33) Phosphate manufacturing.

(34) Plastics and synthetics.

(35) Printing.

(36) Pulp, paper, and paperboard mills.

(37) Rubber processing.

(38) Sewage treatment works, privately owned.

(39) Soap and detergent manufacturing.

(40) Steam electric power generating.

(41) Steam supply.

(42) Sugar processing.

(43) Textile industry.

(44) Timber products processing.

(45) Transportation industries.

(46) Water supply.
