

IN THE MATTER OF AMENDING CHAPTER MVD 11 OF THE WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, RELATING TO POINT VALUES FOR TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS

ORDER ADOPTING AMENDMENT

Pursuant to authority vested in the Administrator of the Division of Motor Vehicles of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation under Sections 110.06 and 343.32 (2), Wisconsin Statutes, and after due notice and public hearing held the 15th day of December, 1976, at the Quality Inn, 4916 East Broadway, Madison, Wisconsin; and, after giving due consideration to the objections and suggestions of those persons attending such public hearing relative to the various portions of the rule;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Chapter MVD 11.03 (20), of the Wisconsin Administrative Code, relating to point values for traffic violations, be amended as follows:

11.03 (20) All other moving traffic convictions, except the following: 2

- (a) Failure to pay public service permit fee
- (b) Operating in excess of authority granted by public service commission
- (c) Failure to register vehicle
- (d) Improper license plates
- (e) Overload on license or overload on axle
- (f) Failure to transfer certificate of title
- (g) Unnecessary blowing of horn
- (h) Improper muffler
- (i) Violation of boulevard ordinance
- (j) Operating with studded tires outside of authorized period
- (k) Failure to wear mandatory protective headgear while operating a motor driven cycle
- (1) Operating a motor driven cycle with handlebars that exceed the legal height limit
- (m) Operating a motor driven cycle with rear passenger pegs that are at an illegal height
