

Chapter Med 3**LICENSE TO PRACTICE MEDICINE AND SURGERY
FOR THOSE HOLDING LICENSES IN THIS STATE
TO PRACTICE OSTEOPATHY AND SURGERY;
GENERAL REQUIREMENTS****Med 3.01 Application procedure**

History: 1-2-56; Ch. Med 3 as it existed on June 30, 1969 was repealed and a new chapter Med 3 was created, Register, June, 1969, No. 162, eff. 7-1-69; Ch. Med 3 as it existed on July 31, 1970 was repealed and a new chapter Med 3 was created, Register, July, 1970, No. 175, eff. 8-1-70.

Med 3.01 Application procedures. A person licensed in Wisconsin to practice osteopathy and surgery may obtain a license to practice medicine and surgery in the following manner:

- (1) Filing an application on form provided by the board setting forth the date the applicant was licensed to practice, the number of years and place or places in which he has practiced.
- (2) Completion of refresher course in materia medica and pharmacology; a refresher course which meets the statutory requirements, or a regular course offered in an approved medical or osteopathic college, will be accepted.
- (3) Pass an examination given by the board in materia medica and pharmacology
- (4) Payment of fee in the amount of \$25.
- (5) Surrender of old license.
