ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD

CREATING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by sections 23.09, 23.11, 27.01, 29.174 and chapter 227, Wisconsin Statutes, the Natural Resources Board hereby creates rules as follows:

SECTION 1 - NR 11.33 is created to read:

NR 11.33 Closed area; state trails. A closed season is established on the following described areas, and it is unlawful for any person to take, catch, kill, hunt, trap or pursue in any manner any species of wild animals or birds on such lands during the period from February 1 through the Friday preceding the Saturday nearest October 27, both dates inclusive.

- (1) Green county. (a) Sugar River state trail. A strip of land 100 feet wide more or less, commencing in New Glarus and including the following descriptions:

SECTION 2 - NR 45.01 (3) (r) is created to read:

(r) Bicycle. Every device propelled by the feet acting upon pedals and having one or more wheels.

SECTION 3 - NR 45.08 (11) is created to read:

(11) It shall be unlawful to operate any bicycle upon land posted as closed by the department to use by bicycles.

SECTION 4 - NR 45.18 (3) is created to read:

(3) This section is not applicable to the Sugar River state trail.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on July 22, 1976.
