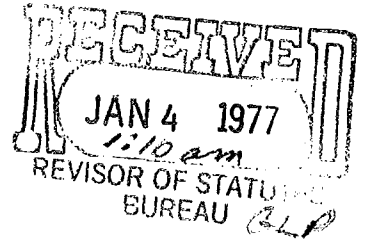



ADOPTING, AMENDING AND REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Accounting Examining Board,  
Department of Regulation and Licensing, by section 15.08(5), Wis. Stats.,  
the Accounting Examining Board hereby adopts rules as follows:

Section Chapter Accy 2.12 of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is  
repealed.

Section Chapter Accy 2.12 of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is  
adopted to read:

Accy 2.12 Transcript of proceedings. (1) Stenographic, electronic,  
or other record of Class 2 and Class 3 hearings shall be made.

(a) Persons requesting transcripts for appeal or for other reasonable  
purposes as determined by the board shall compensate the board at the rate  
of ten cents per page. If such persons are impecunious, they shall be  
furnished a transcript at board expense upon the filing of a verified  
petition stating that they are without the means to purchase a transcript.

The rules, amendments, and repeals contained herein shall take  
effect on February 1, 1977, pursuant to authority granted by section  
227.026(1)(b).

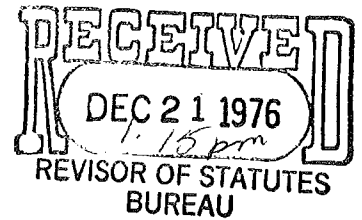



Section Chapter Accy 2.12 of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is  
repealed.

Section Chapter Accy 2.12 of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is  
adopted to read:

Accy 2.12 Transcript of proceedings. (1) A record of all hearings  
involving possible disciplinary action shall be made by stenographic  
reporter, electronic recorder, or other means as the board may direct.

(a) Parties requesting transcripts of the record shall compensate  
the board for the preparation of such a transcript at the usual and  
customary rate.

(b) Parties who are impecunious who require a transcript for  
appeal or other reasonable purposes shall be furnished with a transcript  
by the board, upon the filing of a verified petition stating that they  
are without means to purchase a transcript.

The rules, amendments, and repeals contained herein shall take  
effect on February 1, 1977, pursuant to authority granted by section  
227.026(1)(b).
