

WINE CONTAINER SIZES

Sections Tax 8.42(1) and (4) of the Wis. Adm. Code are amended to read:

- Tax 8.42(1) No manufacturer, rectifier, wholesaler, winery, retailer or any person licensed for the sale of wine shall have in his <u>or her</u> possession within this state, on his licensed premises or stored otherwise, wine for sale in any container of a net content of more than a gallon 5 gallons except under sub. (4).
- (4) Manufacturers, rectifiers, wholesalers and wineries may have wine upon their licensed premises in containers larger than a gallon 5 gallons for purposes of bottling or rectification in containers no larger than one gallon, or for shipment out of the state.
