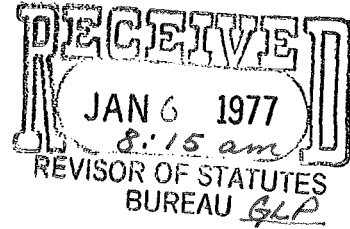

ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION

REPEALING RULES


This is an order of the State Superintendent of Public Instruction repealing rule PI 3.20 (8) (b) 4., of the Wisconsin Administrative Code.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Public Instruction, Sections 121.15 and subsection 20.255 (1) (r), and Chapter 227, Wisconsin Statutes, the State Superintendent of Public Instruction hereby repeals the following rule:

PI 3.20 (8) (b) 4. ~~"The maximum materials fee that may be charged for an approved course is \$5. For students who are not residents of the district, a tuition fee may also be charged. However, in no case may the total of the materials fee, tuition, and aid exceed the actual cost of instruction."~~

The repeal contained herein shall take effect on the first day following its publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register.
