ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION

REPEALING RULES

This is an order of the State Superintendent of Public Instruction repealing rule PI 3.20 (8) (b) 4., of the Wisconsin Administrative Code.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Public Instruction,
Sections 121.15 and subsection 20.255 (1) (r), and Chapter 227, Wisconsin
Statutes, the State Superintendent of Public Instruction hereby repeals
the following rule:

PI 3.20 (8) (b) 4. "The-maximum-materials-fee-that-may-be-charged for-an-approved-course-if-\$5.--For-students-who-are-not-residents of-the-district,-a-thition-fee-may-also-be-charged.--However,-in no-case-may-the-total-of-the-materials-fee,-tuition,-and-aid-exceed the-actual-cost-of-instruction."

The repeal contained herein shall take effect on the first day following its publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register.
