## ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH & SOCIAL SERVICES ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Health and Social Services in Chapter 39, Laws of 1975, and in accordance with Chapter 227, Wis. Stats., the following rules are hereby promulgated:

Section H 62.19(2)(a)17 is amended to read:

17. Steel septic tanks. For general tank design see section (H 62.20 (4) (a) and (b) and H 62.19 (2) (a) 17. Steel tanks shall be fabricated of new, hot rolled commercial steel. The tanks including cover with rim, inlet and outlet collars and manhole extension collars shall be fabricated with welded joints in such manner as to provide structural stability and water tightness.

Steel tanks shall be coated, inside and outside in compliance with U.L. Standard 70 Bituminous Coated Metal Septic Tanks. Any damage to the bituminous coating shall be repaired by recoating. The gauge of the steel shall be as follows:
