

AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by sections 23.09, 29.174 and 227.014, Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends rules as follows:

SECTION 1 - Section NR 10.01 (3) (e) 1. a. is amended to read:

a. In the counties or parts of counties of Brown, Calumet, Dane (west of state highway 78 and north of U.S. highway 18), Door, Fond du Lac, Kewaunee, Manitowoc, Outagamie, Sheboygan, Shawano (south of state highway 29), Waupaca and Winnebago.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on December 16, 1976.
