ORDER OF THE VETERINARY EXAMINING BOARD ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Veterinary Examining Board by Sections 15.08(5) and 453.06, Wis. Stats., the Veterinary Examining Board repeals, amends and adopts rules as follows:

Section VE 2.03 Educational qualifications of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is amended to read:

Applicants for license shall submit proof of graduation from an approved school of veterinary medicine. Schools in the United States and Canada, approved by the American Veterinary Medical Association are approved by the board. Graduates of schools outside the United States and Canada are required to complete the educational commission for foreign veterinary graduates certification program of the American Veterinary Medical Association as a pre-requisite to eligibility for examination. The educational commission for foreign veterinary graduates certificate shall accompany the application for examination. Temporary permits may be issued by the board but only to graduates of schools in the United States and Canada.

Sections VE 2.04(2), VE 2.08(3)(b), and VE 2.09(1) of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE are repealed.

Section VE 2.09(2), renumbered VE 2.09(1) WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is amended to read:

The board members shall report one score which shall be arrived at by scoring 50% for the written and 50% for the oral/practical portion.

Section VE 2.09(3) is renumbered VE 2.09(2) and Section VE 2.09(4) is renumbered VE 2.09(3).
