WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE

CHAPTER MED 10

UNPROFESSIONAL CONDUCT DEFINED

10.02 (2) (s) Prescribing, ordering, dispensing, administering, supplying, selling, or giving any amphetamine drug or compound or derivative, congener or analogue thereof to or for any person except for the treatment of narcolepsy, or for the treatment of hyperkinesia, or for the treatment of drug induced brain dysfunction, or for the differential diagnostic psychiatric evaluation of depression, or for the treatment of depression shown to be refractory to other therapeutic modalities, or for the clinical investigation of the effects of such drugs or compounds in which case an investigative protocol therefore shall have been submitted to and reviewed and approved by the board before such investigation has been begun.
