## ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Department of Public Instruction by Section 115.28(7), Wis. Stats., the State Superintendent of Public Instruction hereby adopts rules as follows:

That PI 3.03(4)(c) is created to read:

PI 3.03(4)(c) A properly licensed special education teacher who has been successfully employed (as verified by the secretary of the department of health and social services or designee or the private agency administrator) as an early childhood—handicapped teacher in a program for handicapped children for 2 semesters between July 1, 1973, and July 1, 1978, shall be certified in early childhood—exceptional educational needs.
